



- 7. There are some goods acquired by the household from the exchange of goods (barter), for example, the family gives an amount of flour and receives in return tomatoes. Record in the notebook the value of the tomatoes it acquired at the price
- 8. In all other cases the household which consumes a commodity that it did not spend on, as commodities received from other households or for work, include the item and
- 9. If the household bought an item on credit (debt) during the time reference (7 days), record the full purchasing value in the household expenditure as soon as it acquires the commodity.
- 10. Do not record in the notebook expenditure on goods and services used for productive purposes such as expenditure on fuel for taxis (taxi) or for machines and pumps used in the farm. Record only the value and the amount of gasoline used for the purposes
