

- Differences between ELMPS 2023: xs all v2.2 & v2.3

The changes between the ELMPS 2023 xs all v2.2 and v2.3 datasets are limited to 4 variables. The reasons for these changes, along with the number of mismatched observations, are illustrated below:

usempstp: Substance work is now included in the calculation of the `usempstp` variable in v2.3, whereas it was not included in v2.2. The mismatches for this variable are 2368 observations between v2.2 and v2.3.

usinstsec: The definition of formality has been revised to depend solely on social security coverage. Since `usinstsec` is determined based on formality, its definition also differs across versions: in v2.2, `usinstsec` is based on the previous definition of formality, whereas in v2.3, it is based on the revised definition, as illustrated. The mismatches for this variable are 2368 observations between v2.2 and v2.3.

hrwgAllJob: There was an issue with the calculated duration of secondary jobs for some observations in v2.2, which has been corrected in v2.3. The mismatches for this variable are 118 observations between v2.2 and v2.3.

mnthwgAllJob: The duration should be divided by 3 to obtain the monthly value. This adjustment was not applied in v2.2 but has been correctly implemented in v2.3. The mismatches for this variable are 399 observations between v2.2 and v2.3.

- Differences between ELMPS 2023: rep xs v2.2 & v2.3

The changes between the ELMPS 2023 rep xs v2.2 and v2.3 datasets are limited to 9 variables. The reasons for these changes, along with the number of mismatched observations, are illustrated below:

crformal: 49581 mismatches. The value labels in v2.2 were 1 for yes and 2 has no label, while in version 2.3 it is corrected to 0 “Informal” 1 “Formal”. The mismatches for this variable are 49581 observations between v2.2 and v2.3.

crinstsec: The definition of formality has been revised to depend solely on social security coverage. Since `crinstsec` is determined based on formality, its definition also differs across versions: in v2.2, `crinstsec` is based on the previous definition of formality, whereas in v2.3, it is based on the revised definition, as illustrated. The mismatches for this variable are 865 observations between v2.2 and v2.3.

usempstp: Substance work is now included in the calculation of the `usempstp` variable in v2.3, whereas it was not included in v2.2 for round 2023. The mismatches for this variable are 2368 observations between v2.2 and v2.3.

usformal: The value labels in v2.2 were 1 for yes and 2 has no label, while in version 2.3 it is corrected to 0 “Informal” 1 “Formal”. The mismatches for this variable are 51835 observations between v2.2 and v2.3.

usinstsec: The definition of formality has been revised to depend solely on social security coverage. Since `usinstsec` is determined based on formality, its definition also differs across versions: in v2.2, `usinstsec`

is based on the previous definition of formality, whereas in v2.3, it is based on the revised definition, as illustrated. The mismatches for this variable are 3226 observations between v2.2 and v2.3.

hrwgAllJob: There was an issue with the calculated duration of secondary jobs for some observations in v2.2, which has been corrected in v2.3. The mismatches for this variable are 1213 observations between v2.2 and v2.3.

mnthwgAllJob: The duration should be divided by 3 to obtain the monthly value. This adjustment was not applied in v2.2 but has been correctly implemented in v2.3. The mismatches for this variable are 3667 observations between v2.2 and v2.3.

RhrwgAllJobCPI23: Since the variable `hrwgAllJob` has been revised, the variable `RhrwgAllJobCPI23` should also be updated accordingly, resulting in 706 mismatched observations.

RmnthwgAllJobCPI23: Since the variable `mnthwgAllJobCPI23` has been revised, the variable `RmnthwgAllJobCPI23` should also be updated accordingly, resulting in 706 mismatched observations.
